Features and Benefits:

- Easy registration
 - Interested parties self-register and select interest areas called Content Areas.
 - Full registration occurs when these parties are vetted.
- Login (registration) drives information flow
 - Once registered, the Content Areas to which a member is subscribed drives what information is displayed
 - All member information (all members of the network)
 - Just relevant to the individual
 - Selected (sorted) by the member
- Shared Data types
 - Membership data
 - Selected (sorted) by the member's Content Area
 - Information about team members in the network
 - Personal contact information (as supplied by members)
 - Events
 - Selected (sorted) by the member's Content Area
 - A calendar of events (items set by Content Area leaders)
 - Downloadable to your PDA
 - Deadlines, meetings, conference calls
 - RSS Feed¹
 - News
 - Selected (sorted) by the member's Content Area
 - Important updates
 - Changes on topics, direction, works in progress
 - RSS Feed
 - Library
 - Selected (sorted) by the member's Content Area
 - Documents relevant to the group or all groups
 - Documents are uploaded and downloaded easily
 - Multiple formats accepted
 - Documents may be updated (versions are archived)
 - Documents may be deleted (by author or leader)
 - This feature is the backbone for future publication efforts.
